From Canton/Akron/Cleveland:

Follow I-77 south to Route 30 & Route 62 west. Rt. 30 & 62 will separate. Continue on Rt. 62 through Navarre and proceed to Wilmot. In Wilmot, turn right @ first traffic light (Route 250 west). Follow Rt. 250 out of town for about a mile. After crossing a small bridge over a creek, turn right immediately onto Alabama Ave. Proceed half mile to the entrance.

From Wooster:

Follow Rt. 250 east through Apple Creek & Mount Eaton. TWC is about 4 miles east of Mount Eaton. Turn left off of Rt. 250 onto Alabama Ave., just before a bridge over a creek. Proceed half mile to the entrance.

From Dover/New Philadelphia:

Travel north on I-77 to Strasburg exit. Turn left and drive through Strasburg. Pass the drive-in theater and turn left onto Rt. 250 W. Follow Rt. 250 through Wilmot. After crossing a small bridge over a creek, turn right immediately onto Alabama Ave. Proceed half mile to the entrance.
